International Course on

Advanced Food Analysis

The Graduate School VLAG and the FP7 EU project CONFIDENCE are pleased to announce an international one-week course on Advanced Food Analysis at Wageningen University, The Netherlands.

Who should attend

- PhD students in the areas of food chemistry, food safety and food quality;
- R&D professionals from food industry, research and quality institutes.

Course program

The course program is currently being developed and will comprise presentations by international experts in the field, an excursion and social events. Course topics are: advanced sample handling, chromatography and electrophoresis, spectrometry, imaging, bioanalytical techniques, biosensors, omics technologies, data handling and chemometrics, and validation and legislation. These advanced analytical tools will be discussed in relation to state-of-the-art food analysis issues such as residues and contaminants, authenticity and traceability, flavours and odours, processing and packaging contaminants, biotoxins, allergens, novel and organic foods and supplements. The course will start with a half day “back-to-basics” in order to refresh the basics of analytics.
